Children with a rare form of leukemia can suffer devastating blood clotting abnormalities that can cause early death before their cancer treatment has a chance to be effective. With the support of the CRCM, oncology researchers are conducting a study investigating new biomarkers of coagulation status in conjunction with a world-wide Children's Oncology Group (COG) therapeutic clinical trial.

CHM's Hematology-Oncology group is conducting this important research in conjunction with a world-wide therapeutic clinical trial. Children will have their blood clotting status assessed using specialized new techniques in an effort to improve clinicians' ability to identify adverse clotting events.
